## Presidents Report 2016

This report covers 21 months as it was not possible to table a report at the disruptive AGM we tried to hold in March 2015 at Beaufort West.

Due to circumstances that prevailed in early part of 2015 a large backlog of work had to be processed. We re-invented the Society web-site and purchased a new computer as well as a pastel system enabling the Treasurer to update and improve the financial department. We received good comments regarding the web-site with only two members finding fault therewith. Lynette Blackie did a sterling job as Secretary and tried to the best of her ability to sort out the various problems that some members were experiencing, but we still had a few members complaining if their queries or problems were not attended too immediately. I find that members that complain the most are always those persons that do the least for the Society. We disassociated the Society from the journal and are now printing bi-annual newsletters to record championships and Society news.

Council convened and held a SGM on 8<sup>th</sup> August 2015 using the same agenda of the disruptive AGM that was held at Beaufort West in March 2015. Because of the unruly behaviour of some Western Cape members the AGM was totally unconstitutional. The members concerned had no idea of meeting procedure and made it impossible to hold a properly constituted meeting. Subsequent to the meeting 11 of those members resigned and their resignations were accepted and recorded. The SGM declared the AGM of 20 March 2015 unconstitutional and attended to the matters on the agenda. Lynette Blackie resigned as Secretary due to personal reasons and I thank her for all the time and effort she put in whilst in office. Sue Cook was appointed as Acting Secretary.

We have sorted out many problems and the Eastern Cape now has an elected committee with George Muller as Council representative. Western Cape also held a meeting, has a full committee and Paul Carstens is the Regional Councillor. The Free State has Adv Willem Edeling as their representative on Council. Sue Cook had discussions with Natal members and we should soon have a Natal representative appointed. The 2016 Nationals

being held now are the first multi discipline National championships ever staged by our Society.

I want to record my thanks to George Muller and Paul Carstens for so readily stepping forward to assist when needed. To all fellow councillors who have served on Council with me namely Adv Willem Edeling, Mike Bernstein, Lynette Blackie and Nicolas Muller, thank you for your contribution. A special thank you to Sue Cook for once again stepping forward to assist in the secretarial position and also for organising this National Championship.

In closing I want to ask all our members to pull together, to put the ponies and cobs as priority and self interest last. Let us all work together as a team and grow our Society

## National Championships 2016

*Report from Joanna Sheil*

### **Judging in South Africa.**

I arrived in South Africa on Sunday the first of May following the long flight from London. I was met at the airport by Sydney Kidson one of my co- judges and we travelled down to Bloemfontein together where we met up with Bev Williamson , the other co-judge and Sue Cook.

My first day was all the breed classes. Unlike at home where all the section classes are judged in order, the classes of each section were spread through the day. This is to allow competitors to bring their next exhibits without worrying about back to back classes; a real help to exhibitors but not so easy to follow for a judge!!

The section A classes were the most numerous with some nice ponies. My champion was Paddock Hill Sun Coquet, a good type of mare who really moved and put on an excellent show each time she came into the ring. She had real “look at me” presence and was shown to full advantage by her handler Witness. The same stud also won both the Junior Championships with the filly Paddock Hill Sun Carousel and the colt Paddock Hill Sun Glitter. For me they were all a good type of pony with correct conformation, good limbs, and were presented well on the day.

The second placed senior mare was Gwyddls Diva's Delight shown by Paul Lubbinge. She was a scopey mare with a good front – very much my type of pony but unfortunately she did not move well on the day.

The reserve champion was the senior stallion Gwyddls Showtime. Again a nice mover and a good type of stallion with correct conformation with perhaps a little more elegance than the champion.

The use of a tight check rein for the exhibits also used for driving meant they were too thick under the neck where they had developed additional muscle and I particularly like a well set on front.

The section Bs were much thinner in the ground but my champion was the young colt National Prince Larkspur again a nice type with lovely substance who will no doubt become a real asset to section B breeding in South Africa.

The section D classes were not as well filled as the section As but there were some nice animals present. On the whole they had good bone and limbs with nice free movement. One or two were clipped out down the legs as they competed in different disciplines which made them look lighter of limb although it is good to see the cobs going on to the fly the flag in all areas of equine sports. A few lacked quality through the front, but there was plenty of quality in my champion Llandilo Pentagon a lovely type of stallion.

Following the breed classes I judged the ridden classes that were English style. The standard of these classes was quite mixed but the enthusiasm by all the competitors was lovely to see. My champion, ridden by Chrisme Venter, was Kallista Lord Reuben, who performed well each time asked.

The lead-rein class had some lovely exhibits and was won by Staten Cuprum and Lindsay Balmer. At home the first ridden classes have a lower height restriction which means they are many section As or small Bs so it was a bit of a shock to see larger animals coming in. However they went how I had hoped for a first ridden – sensible rides for younger and novice riders. My winner was Sparkling Almond Delight ridden by Jemima Bester.

I joined my fellow judges for the driven classes and that is no doubt where the strength of South African Welsh ponies and cobs lie! For me the fashion of the tight check rein (ophaler) restricted the forward extension of some of the ponies but there were some terrific displays. The overall champion was Hansu Hamlet driven by Duane Dreyer. The final day saw the team of 8 – something very rare back home. It was an honour to have a ride around the show ground.

As well as the driven all three judges did the fancy dress. What a lovely but challenging class to judge! So much effort had gone into the costumes! I really enjoyed my visit to South Africa and judging at your National Show. What struck me was the enthusiasm shown by the competitors. So many of the animals took part in many classes – true all-round animals showing the strength of the Welsh breeds. I was pleased to hear that some of the problems of the SA society were getting ironed out. The Welsh breeds are something to be very proud of, and a united society will be able to showcase this fully. I have been lucky enough to judge Welsh ponies and cobs around the world, and you certainly have something worth being proud of!!

## **Paddock Hill Sun Coquet**

The 2016 National Championships was the arena for two particularly noteworthy events. The first of these was the achievement of Paddock Hill Sun Coquet in becoming the first Welsh Mountain Pony Mare to win the Supreme Champion Section A and Supreme Champion Purebred three years in a row; each time with a renowned U.K. judge: Simon Bigley, Steve Everitt and Joanna Sheil respectively.

Paddock Hill Sun Coquet started her winning ways at Nationals in 2010 when she was the Junior Champion Sec. A mare and Reserve Supreme Champion Sec. A judged by Mrs. Jo Lutey then in 2012 under John Hendy she was the Senior Champion Sec. A mare and Reserve Supreme Champion Sec. A before she started her Supreme Championship achievements defeating some highly successful stallions en route. At Regional level she has taken Supreme Champion on 5 occasions and she has earned 5 Legion of Merit Awards. Very few ponies of either sex have reached this level and it will be fascinating to see whether her siblings or progeny reach these heights in years to come.

## Frosty Lager

The second note-worthy event was the retirement of the long-time show stalwart Frosty Lager at the grand old age of 26yrs.

Bred by the Frosty Stud in Kimberley & born in 1990, Lager was sired by the imported Cob stallion Oak Hatch Flight out of Frosty Tafflin whose Sire was the imported Sinton Gilbert.

Lager started his nationals Show career in 1993 and has not missed a Championship for the last 23 years. He has won 76 South African Championships over this period, some of them for 11 years in succession and holds the record for the most Championships (8) won at a single National Championship. His riders & drivers during this time were Hylton & Cindy Frost, their son & daughter Cody & Seghoné and family friend Jenni Van Kerkhoff.

Frosty Lager has also been active outside the show ring. Apart from teaching Seghoné, Cody and Jenni to ride and driving them to Matric farewells, he has competed in Endurance, Polocrosse, Tent pegging, "Boeresport", Dressage and even Show Jumping.

Lager will be retiring to his beautiful home in Cradock where he will run with his band of mares & hopefully produce some equally versatile progeny to follow in his footsteps.

## Horse of the Year Show 2016

I was privileged to judge at the South African Horse of the year show in February 2016 at Kyalami Park Club. After long months of rain and mud during the winter we set off from Amsterdam (still raining), looking forwards to two weeks of sunshine, well stocked up with sunglasses, straw hats and sun-block cream. After an overnight flight of almost 11 hours we landed at Cape Town airport. We stayed the first week with family and then took a flight to Johannesburg. We were met by Rob, the owner and host of the “Owls Loft” guesthouse where we stayed for the week. During the five days show I had to judge some seventy different classes – all the Welsh sections in hand and some of the ridden classes, the miniatures horses, the SA Boerperd and on Sunday I was involved in the judging of some of the Supreme Championships.

On Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> of February I had to judge the Welsh ponies and had some lovely entries. The section A classes yielded some beautiful ponies, with my lovely senior mare champion Gwyddls Debudante in ownership of Wehlia de Villiers and the super moving senior stallion champion Tipuana Flamboyant; he was in the ownership of the Tipuana stud. Both ponies had lovely quality, were of good type and the stallion was a real Welshman with lots of character, lovely big eyes and could really move. The young stock classes were a little disappointing with ponies rather backward in condition in some sections and rather lacking in type. The section A junior champion was the two year old filly Tipuana Foxy’s Charm in the ownership of the Tipuana stud and she had the quality and movement I was looking for in a pony.

Section B's also produced some good ones and the Senior stallion champion and supreme champion of the section B was the UK imported stallion Heniarth Top of the Morning in ownership of Dolarch stud. This lovely grey stallion was an example for the breed, with great conformation, type and expression. If I may say something about this stallion then he could have moved a little bit better but he was so beautiful that there was nothing that could beat him. He was also the pony that on Sunday won the Supreme Inter-Breed Championships.

There were no section C's and the section D's were disappointing both in numbers and type, ponies lacking substance, depth and movement. The senior champion of the D's was the mare Frejya Fflam Goch of Sharon Ralston.

Part-Breds were the strongest in numbers of the Welsh ponies and there seems to be more demand for these as ridden ponies than for the pure-breds. The supreme champions both came from the two mare classes. Reserve Supreme champion Part-bred was the lovely barren mare Foresyte Bee Bop in ownership of Teagan Johnston and the supreme Part-bred champion was the senior mare Waterside Sienna from the Waterside stud.

The all sections gelding class winner was a splendid grey Partbred, Waterside Blue Token also owned by the Waterside stud. This gorgeous gelding had everything, depth, movement, type and excellent conformation.

The ridden classes had endless different sections. The standard of the children's riding, right down the line, was impressive and the ridden ponies were, without exception, very happy and relaxed, due, no doubt, to the quiet hands and good legs of their riders. This was explained to me as being the result of ponies being used for many different activities but I felt that there must be some very good basic tuition. At the end of the five days it was lovely to see the ridden ponies still going sweetly and with plenty of presence, in spite of many of them having taken part in a number of different classes.

At the end of our visit in South Africa we visited the Tipuana stud on the day we flew back home. This stud was only 80 km away from the place where we stayed and had very comparable bloodlines to my own stud and it was great to see their ponies.

We shall not forget the hospitality and kindness we received while in South Africa and our visit was certainly one of a lifetime. My grateful thanks to all those who gave up their time to making our stay such a memorable one.

## Royal Welsh 2016

On Sunday 17 July 2016 the International meeting took place in the International Pavilion, Royal Welsh Showground.

The chair welcomed us and invited everybody to attend the opening of the WPCS Pavilion after the meeting.

It was interesting to meet everybody from different societies. It was obvious throughout the discussions that the effect of Brexit was a big concern for the European Societies.

One of the interesting discussions was about the show – clothing. Everybody was united in their understanding of the rule that BLUE DENIM is **not allowed** in the welsh pony show ring... it took quite a while to get to this point ...

Next was another lengthy discussion about the stallion licensing...what should and what should not be taken in consideration by the veterinary when issuing the license. The mother society will supply a clear standard to the daughter societies.

Maybe one of the most interesting and disturbing discussions was about three stallions that were exported to the Netherlands from the UK. When the necessary DNA tests were done the results showed that the pedigrees of these stallions were not correct. The foals could not be registered in the Netherlands. The question was what the Mother Society should do to help and to prevent this happening in the future. It was proposed that the MS should see to it that only horses with the correct DNA profiles that matched their written pedigrees can be exported. DNA testing has only recently been introduced(only for stallions) in UK and Europe ... as DNA testing has been compulsory from 1998 in South Africa for all the Welsh Ponies and Cobs, on this matter we seem to be light years ahead of the other societies. The importance of DNA identification cannot be over emphasized. Breeding is an art that involves all the ancestors to produce the correct type and preserve the true welsh ponies and Cobs for future generations.

It is important to emphasize that, The WPCS DOES NOT CONDONE OR SUPPORT ANY WRONG PEDIGREES ISSUED TO HORSES BEING EXPORTED.

The next International show (the 19<sup>th</sup>) will be held in the Netherlands in 2017. A presentation and invitation was made to all the societies. The International show of 2019 will be in Australia.

We adjourned and attended the unveiling of the refurbished exterior of the WPCS Pavilion, President Elizabeth French and Chair John Kirk welcomed members from near and far.

Attending were President- Elect Ifor Lloyd, Chief Executive Officer Rob Allen, trustees from the Society's Council and representatives from the overseas societies of Germany, Ireland, France, the Netherlands, Belgium, Sweden, the USA, Africa, South Africa, and Australia.

In a short ceremony Chair Kirk thanked all those who had contributed to the refurbishment and complemented the builders on their outstanding work. President French remarked on how refreshing it was to see the improvements, how appreciative the members who use the building will be, and cut the ribbon to great applause.

The Pavilion's roof has been completely replaced, the exterior has been re-stained and decorated and new internal flooring has been installed.



On the first day more than 51,000 people (and four Pokémon) came through the gates to see the cream of Welsh livestock, the finest produce from across Wales and plenty of entertainment made the right mix for a great day out for all the family.

After the grand opening there was a very nice ceremony of the planting of a Golden Willow on the Llanelwedd showground. The tree was dug in to mark the 90th birthday of the Queen, who is the show's patron.

I promised beforehand that I will bring sunshine from South Africa and I did my best as it was a week of extreme heat and sunshine. (When I left the next Sunday the rain started...)

For the first time in many, many years show judges were being allowed to remove jackets in the show rings but were expected to retain their ties. Ice cream vendors saw a roaring trade as visitors tried to find ways to cool down.

I was honoured with the company of Mrs Betty French (The 80 year old EI Presidente) on the first and the second day. She is a source of information and seems to know almost everybody who is somebody. We had hilarious moments and I was astounded by her energy and knowledge.

As this was my second visit to the Royal Welsh and right from the start of the second day I could see a big difference between classes of 2015 and the classes of 2016...especially the sec A's. The classes were significantly smaller than the 2015 show...I think I heard somebody said that there were more than 200 less entries than in 2012.

It was also a distinct type of pony that was shown. The "hill ponies" have extreme dished heads and lots of bone ... shorter in the bodies than what we are used to in South Africa. It was obvious that only this type of ponies were shown as the judge preferred this type.

I was impressed by the judging of the sec B's and C's...and the quality and standard was very high...especially the sec B's. The judge tended to prefer the old type of sec B's with more bone. Her winner also became the overall reserve champion of all the breeds.

The main event of the third day was the Welsh Cob display in the main ring of the showground, where stallions, mares and foals took to the ring to rapturous applause and cheers.

Excitement and anticipation ran high for the presentation of the eagerly-awaited George Prince of Wales Perpetual Cup, Brightwells Ltd Rug and RWAS Championship Rosette for the best Welsh Cob.

Wednesday is Cob Day at the Royal Welsh Show in Llanellwedd, often seen as the busiest day of the event; where a football-like grandstand crowd cheer in appreciation as hopeful Welsh Cob breeders parade their horses, hoping to secure the George Prince of Wales Cup.

After tense competition, it was Cascob Brenin Dafydd, owned by the Owens family of Presteigne, Powys, who was the winner of the 2016 prestigious cup. The reserve went to Rhencullen Princess.

The success of the show is renowned around the world with coverage of the show live-streamed internationally throughout the four-days. Nearly 1000 visitors registered at the International Pavilion from over 30 different countries from as far afield as Australia, USA, Russia, Vietnam, Hong Kong, and India, South Africa, to name just a few.

It has been a privilege to attend this show...it is must for al Welsh pony and Cob breeders, owners and admirers.
