National Championships 2017

The 2017 Welsh Pony & Cob Society National Championships will be held in conjunction with the **Robertson Agricultural Show** from 3rd to 7th October 2017

These championships will only be open to paid-up members of the Welsh Pony and Cob Society of South Africa and no late entries, entries on the day or unapproved changes to entries will be allowed.

The Breed classes will follow the format approved at the A.G.M. 2016 Junior Classes will include a foal under 12mths; filly one year to under four years & automatic Junior Championship, Colt one year to under four years & automatic Junior Championship. Senior classes will be Mares and Registered Stallions over four years & automatic Senior Championships.

Should entries warrant these classes may be further divided by age.

Classes for barren Mares, stallions not registered for breeding and geldings will also be offered.

There will be separate breed classes for all four Purebred sections and Purebreds.

New Passports



The re-designed Welsh Pony & Cob Society passports have been fully approved by the State Vet, Boland. These passports will be double-stitched with a strong PVC cover and will be available from the Secretary as of the end of January 2017 at a cost of R60. The passport application forms will be available on the website or from the Secretary and must be returned to the Secretary, fully completed, with proof of payment before any passport can be issued. In terms of our agreement with the State Vet, a copy of the database, recording all issued passports will be submitted to them on a regular basis.

SUMMARY OF MOVEMENT CONTROL REQUIREMENTS

Below is a brief schematic detailing the requirements and responsibilities regarding moving horses in South Africa into AHS control zones of higher control. There are responsibilities from both the horse owner/manager and the private veterinarian to ensure that horses are moved legally and travel with the correct paper work. The primary starting point of movement control is through the completion and submission of the movement application form by the owner/manager of the horses. This allows the smooth processing of requirements in good time so that movements are legal and stress free for all involved. *Courtesy of Equine health Fund Newsletter October 2016*



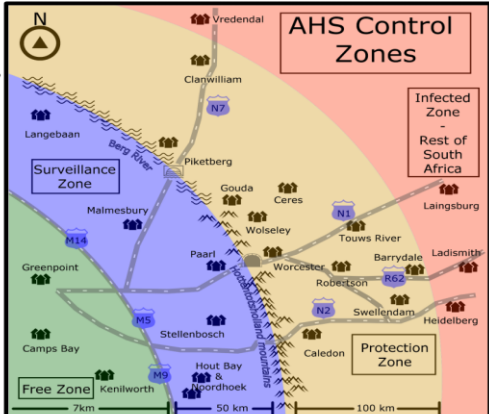
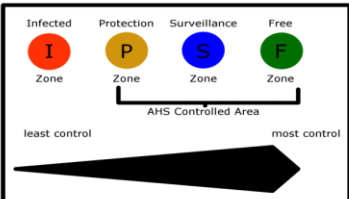

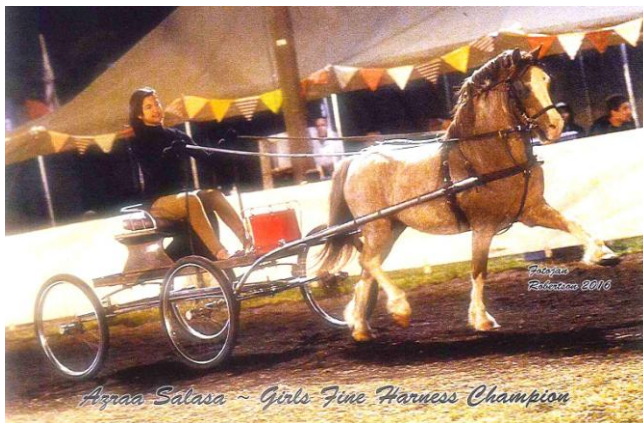

CAPE SHOW HORSE SOCIETY CHAMPIONSHIPS 2016

It is always a privilege to be invited to judge at the Cape Show Horse Society Championships in December; the enthusiasm for the ponies is overwhelming and the competition is huge.

Because this is an Open Show many of the ponies are entered under their stable names rather than their registered names so my report will be rather general in that regard. On Friday we judged in-hand classes and there were some beautiful ponies coming forward. The winning foal I recognized from Robertson Show as Big Show Destiny and I think she is well-named with a great future ahead of her. The Senior stallion class must be the envy of many other shows, with 20 exhibitors forward, all well-presented and of high quality. My final winner was a pony called "De La Rey" who I suspect is actually Millstone Highlight. My favourite pony however was the winner of the senior mare class. She was beautiful, elegant and very-well shown. Her name on the day was Rubie but I was so impressed that I tracked her down as Sunset Cherrie's Dream Girl. I do hope we will see her at Nationals in 2017. On Saturday the fun really started with the harness classes which must be the highlight of any Cape Show. The competition was particularly strong throughout the weekend and, as with Robertson, I was thrilled to see the number of youngsters competing in these classes. The under 12 classes was again, very sensibly, divided into those with and without helpers and it was

wonderful to see how well the ponies reacted to their young drivers. The 12 to 18 class was really impressive and anyone of the top five drivers in that class could hold their own with the senior drivers.

The senior stallion/gelding class was so big that it had to be divided into 2 classes and in both cases my fellow judges and I had to call for a re-ride to help us select the top six from each class. Those that remained were of an excellent standard but sadly some really good ponies also had to go out of the gate.

Sunday was Championship day and in the Senior Single Harness we had eighteen ponies forward. Once again, a re-ride was required but one pony shone throughout. Although he hadn't been at his best on Saturday, finishing second in his class to Adowa Colorado, on Sunday he was back to full form and Adowa Caprice took his final Championship in style. *Sue Cook*

ADOWA CAPRICE



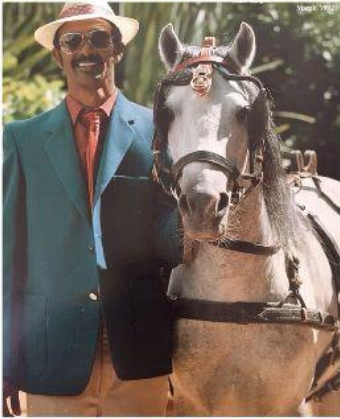

From time to time ponies come along who become legends in their field and Adowa Caprice can certainly count as one of these. His parentage already gave an indication that he was destined for success in harness; his Sire Koosbad Pagad had an incredible career first with his breeder Koos Botha and later particularly in double harness and tandem driven by Mr Boy Human with Adowa Colorado.

Sadly we didn't see much of Caprice outside the Cape Region but his record here speaks for itself.

He was unbeaten as a Junior pony or in any Senior championship. He was Champion Show Horse at Macassa in 2014, Champion three times at Tulbagh, South African National Champion at Beaufort West in 2015, Champion at Clanwilliam in 2016 and finally Cape Show Horse Champion at the CSHS Championships in December 2016. His owner, Adam Majiet has decided to retire him at the top and his presence will be sadly missed at our future shows.

Marwaan Hendricks became a member of WPCS in 1994. His first registered Welsh pony was Bevlon Fortune. They started breeding in 2003 and their first foal was Marwa Pride of Fortune. Marwaan's biggest achievement was when he won the single harness at Robertson late 80's or early 90's, being the first coloured guy to win this. His wife, parents and family support his showing and his daughters (Nuhaa 5, Athraa 11 and Kauthar 16 years old) all compete at the shows. His daughter Athraa helps with the training of the ponies.

Eastern Cape - The Later Years

An article on the Early Years of the Eastern Cape appeared in a publication which was the official Journal of our Society some years and other years wasn't. This is a follow-up.

The Eastern Cape has been home for some time to the four oldest studs in South Africa which continue to breed ponies and cobs. In following order of the years when they registered their first foal are Haelline (1969), Frosty (1976), Ben Hur and Kallista (both 1977). These studs collectively have contributed to our Stud Book for over 160 years and all four are still flourishing.

In the 1990's, influenced by the rising success of the Llandilo Stud, a number of new breeders began operating in East London and the surrounding areas. At one stage there existed somewhere in the order of eight vibrant establishments, but sadly none of them are still in operation. The small town of Hofmeyr also hosted a number of fine studs such as Llanelli (Flip Marais) and Millstone (Willie de Jager).

Regrettably these too have closed their stable doors. Port Elizabeth has never really made a major contribution to our Stud Book apart from the period when Mrs Mackay-Niven's Aberdare Stud was flourishing many years ago.

On a more positive note, PJ and Jean Budler took advantage when Myburgh Streicher's Bukkenburg Stud sold up their mountain ponies to concentrate on breeding cobs. They carefully selected about six top Bukkenburg mares and a beautifully bred stallion, Bukkenburg Vintage. As fate would have it, one of their top mares, Torbry Sungleam, was actually bought as a first pony for Jean's children. This wonderful mare produced the Supreme winners, Llandilo Squire, Sabre and Snowfinch, amongst other first-class stock. The Llandilo Stud dominated both our National Shows and our local Regional Championships for nearly a quarter of a century, and only a great family tragedy forced them to disperse an outstanding collection of ponies and cobs. They won the SF Bailey Shield (awarded for most points on show) virtually every time they exhibited and a number of our present top studs, including Paddock Hill and Tipuana, have bred some or all of their most successful showing stock from Llandilo mares, in some cases using top Llandilo stallions

as well. It was a fitting tribute to the contributions made by PJ and Jean, both on Council and in the showing, that Jean was able to move on practically all her stock at top prices when others were simply forced to give away good quality ponies and cobs, hopefully to good homes, when numbers had to be reduced.

During the last few years of the National Championships, both the Frosty and the Ben Hur studs have kept the flag flying for the Eastern Cape and retained the SF Bailey Shield for our Region. At Regional show level, when this show was still supported by upwards of 70 ponies each year, we welcomed a number of visitors from other Regions. Piet Botha (OFS) competed very successfully in the harness classes, one year winning the Supreme Championship driving a Section B entry, Ben Hur JTM, against all of the top Section A entries.

Professor van Blerk entered their wonderful home-bred Supreme Champion, Paddock Hill Sun Coquet, and dominated the breed classes every year the mare was entered, with her other Paddock Hill ponies also competing very successfully. Wessel Swart brought his Bioci string all the way from Bredasdorp and must have gone home very satisfied with his wins in both harness and in hand.

In the intervening years the Regionals has been supported as always by the four oldest studs, Ben Hur, Frosty, Haelline and Kallista, with much needed additional entries from the Glenwelsh Stud of Elizabeth Ford, our newest Regional Councillor. Elizabeth is the third member of her family to serve on Council after both her parents, Jack and Trudie Gilfillan, had done their stint. The National Stud of Nicolas Muller and Goosen le Roux originally, and then just Nicolas on his own, have had a wonderful show record at Regionals, including showing the Supreme Section A and the Supreme Section B at the same show. Nicolas has recently also had to cut back on his breeding operation, but the showing record of his Supreme Champion, Parcaravel Prince Caspian, will take a lot of beating.

Another grand old campaigner who boasts an unbeatable show record of being exhibited for 25 years is Frosty Lager, who has also been retired recently. This amazing palomino cob was often shown at the same show by three or more members of the Frost family and will long be remembered for his outstanding versatility.

The Ben Hur Stud of George and Gaby Muller once brought over 20 ponies to one Regional Championships which must be something of a numerical record. For the first time in driving class history another notable record was established when grandpa Jack, daughter Elizabeth and granddaughter Sarah, competed against each other in the same single harness championship class. It is highly unlikely that any class has been contested by 3 separate generations. Two other families who have been represented by three generations at different times are the Frost family and the Muller family and this became more complicated when Cindy Muller married Hylton Frost and Spookie Gilfillan married Gavin, Winston Frost's other son.

In 2012 the National Championship Show was hosted at Cradock where the George Muller and Hylton Frost families worked incredibly hard to ensure the Show's success. In 2017 Cradock will again host our Nationals. Since this Show will celebrate our Society's 60th anniversary, it is to be sincerely hoped that the other Regions will give this momentous occasion their unconditional support and, regardless of distance and expense, will come to the Eastern Cape to share in this memorable event. *Derek Kohler*

On the 26th of February 2016, Her Majesty The Queen graciously accepted the recommendation of the Army Honours and Distinctions Committee that 1st The Queen's Dragoon Guards be allowed to keep a mascot. A Welsh Mountain Pony was selected to reflect the Regiment's Welsh heritage.

The Mascot's full title is 16851959 Tpr Emrys Forlan Jones. His number embodies the years of formation for the Queen's Bays and King's Dragoon Guards and the year they were amalgamated to form the QDG in 1959. Emrys means 'The Immortal One' in Welsh and is a name steeped in Welsh history and mythology. Forlan is the name of the Stud who donated the mascot to the Regiment. Jones is a very common surname in the QDG so is always accompanied by the last three numbers of the soldiers service number. Because of this, Emrys can also be known as Tpr Jones 959.

Emrys is Bay coloured as was the tradition of the QDG's antecedent Regiment, The Queen's Bays. The Mascot is accompanied by a handler, known as the 'Farrier Major'. He is identified by a unique rank insignia for the Regiment; four inverted chevrons, an inverted horseshoe and crown.

Emrys and the Farrier Major live and train at Robertson Barracks in Norfolk.

This year, for the first time, Dressage South Africa held a National Youth Championship and Awards evening at Shongweni in KZN for all competitive Dressage riders under the age of 21.

On checking their records it became obvious that many of their top combinations of ponies and riders came from the Welsh Pony ranks. The Welsh Pony & Cob Society was approached for permission to recognize this by allowing the organisers to award medals, ribbons and certificates including both the DSA and Welsh Pony logos. The Society was delighted to agree and one of our Studs has presented a trophy for the highest ranked Welsh pony (either Purebred or Partbred) in the DSA rankings. A special certificate was also presented to the Waterside Welsh Pony Stud in recognition of the significant number of Waterside ponies in the Top ten pony rankings.
