CEM vereistes vir Ponie Registrasie

CEM is 'n akute, hoogs aansteeklike geslagsiekte van perde en affekter 'n merrie se vermoë om beset te raak. Die siekte is in April 2011 in Suid-Afrika aangemeld en die Departement van Landbou, Bosbou en Visserye het 'n bevel uitgereik dat geen hings gebruik mag word om te teel nie, tensy 'n amptelike CEM-klaringsertifikaat uitgereik is.

Dit beteken dat voordat 'n vul (Suiwergeteeld of Deelsgeteeld) wat gebore is na 31 Augustus 2011 by die SA Stamboekvereniging geregistreer kan word en 'n registrasiesertifikaat uitgereik kan word, moet 'n opgedateerde (dws binne 'n jaar), CEM-verklaring vir die hings ingehandig word.

As die hings voor die toets dood is, moet die vul getoets word vir CEM. SASBA het ons ingelig dat **DAFF nou ook vereis dat die merrie vir CEM getoets word en dat die laaste eienaar van die hings 'n beëdigde verklaring moet verskaf wat die dood van die hings bevestig.** Elke geval word as 'n uitsondering behandel en SASBA moet aansoek doen vir individuele vrystelling by DAFF voordat 'n Registrasiesertifikaat uitgereik kan word.

Alle lede word versoek om te verseker dat hul hingste huidige CEM-klaringsertifikaat het as hulle vir teling gebruik word. As u van plan is om iemand anders se hings te gebruik, moet u eers seker maak dat hulle 'n CEM-klaringsertifikaat het, andersins kan ons dalk nie die vul registreer nie.

CEM requirements for Pony Registration

CEM is an acute, highly contagious venereal disease of equines and affects a mare's ability to conceive. It was first reported in South Africa in April 2011 and the Dept. Of Agriculture, Forestry & Fisheries issued an order that no stallion may be used to breed unless an official CEM clearance certificate has been issued.

This means that before any foal (either Purebred or Partbred) born after 31st August 2011 can be registered with SA Studbook Association and be issued with a registration certificate an up to date (i.e. within a year) CEM clearance certificate for the stallion must be submitted.

If the stallion has died prior to testing the foal must be tested & cleared for CEM. SASBA has informed us that **DAFF now also requires that the Dam is tested for CEM and that the last owner of the stallion must provide an affidavit confirming the death of the stallion.** Each case is treated as an exception and SASBA is required to apply for individual exemption from DAFF before a Registration certificate can be issued.

All members are requested to ensure that their stallions have current CEM clearance certificates if they are being used for breeding and if you are planning to use someone else's stallion please first check that they have a CEM clearance certificate or we will not be able to register the foal.

Annual General Meeting 2018

The Annual General Meeting will be held at Robertson Showgrounds on Wednesday 3rd October 2018. All items for the Agenda must reach the Secretary no later than 24th August 2018.

Elections will be held for the positions of Secretary & Treasurer and nominations for these positions must also reach the Office by 24th August 2018. Nomination forms will be emailed to members and will be available on the website.

The current incumbents, Ms. Sue Cook and Mr. George Muller, are both available for re-election.

Judges Exams

Anyone wishing to write the Judges exam in 2018 should contact their Regional Council Member or Administrator.

The theory exam has papers on Breed type & standard, conformation, ring procedure and history. There are separate papers for Riding & Harness classes which can be written at the same time as the Breed exam or later. All papers may be written in English or Afrikaans.

Successful candidates are placed on the learner panel and must judge at least three times with an examining judge before they are promoted to the Junior Judges' panel.

Regional Championships 2018

Western Cape

Western Cape Regional Championships Heidelberg 2018

With the National Championships being held in Robertson, the Western Cape Regional Championships moved to Heidelberg Agricultural Show in February 2018. Although competitor numbers were fewer than 2017 because exhibitors were required to be members of the Society, the classes were extremely strong. The Breed classes were dominated by the Paddock Hill ponies that are so true to the Welsh breed type and standard. One of the foundation mares of the Stud, Llandilo Sundew was the Supreme Champion with her son Paddock Hill Sun Glitter taking the stallion Championship and her grandson Paddock Hill Sun Laureate winning the Junior male award. It has seldom happened in recent years that 3 generations of the same family have featured in the final line-up of a major Championship.

Other ponies to catch the eye in the breed classes were some excellent youngstock from the Dun Haven Stud and the beautiful Junior female Champion Sunset She's A Lady who would feature again in the harness classes.

The ridden classes were very small but Zadaa Jacobs once again showed his riding talent and there were three delightful leadrein entries that we will hopefully see again at Nationals.

As always in the Cape regions the harness classes were very strong and a real pleasure to judge. There were ten exceptional entries in the class for drivers under 12 years with helpers, won by Mogamat Sedick jnr. who really looked as though he would have been at home in the more advanced class.

The class without helpers featured seven very competent drivers and first prize went to Zadaa driving one of the Van Boom family ponies. The 12 to 18 class was contested by drivers who could certainly hold their own among the Adults and won by Keown Barry and Hansu Express with a really professional display. The standard of driving of all these under 18 competitors ensures that we have no need for concern about the future of our Harness classes.

The Junior Champion Single Harness class was won by the beautiful Sunset She's A Lady & this pony is going to prove a real rival to her Dam in future years.

These Championships showed some impressive performances and I think we can look forward to an exceptional National Championships at Robertson in 2018.

Northern Region Championships Horse of the Year 21st February 2018

The Northern Region Championships are held as part of Horse of the year Show, the largest showing show in South Africa, and the Welsh classes invariably have the largest number of entries of the fifteen different breeds taking part.

In 2018 the Breed classes were judged by Ms. Zara Pawley from the U.K. and the ridden classes by Mrs. Shane Mundell.

The Supreme Champion Section A was Gwyddls Showtime, owned by Wehlia De Villiers & shown by Tinus Sonnekus, with Dolarch Stud's Llandilo Hawaii as Reserve. National Prince Spartacus, exhibited by Lynette Blackie, was the Supreme Section B, with another Dolarch pony, Dolarch Tip Top Reserve.

For the first time in many years we had representatives of Section C, Welsh Ponies of Cob type, and this section was won by the stallion Fronarth Brynmor with the mare Hywi Madonna, Reserve. Both ponies were exhibited by Waterside Stud.

In the Cob classes, Freyja Fflam Goch, owned by Sharon Ralston was the Supreme Champion as she has been on several previous occasions. The colt Bendithio Nadezda took the Reserve title.

The Partbred section was won by Tanya Hornschuh's Highover Eliza Dolittle with another foal, Waterside Hollywood as reserve.

The two geldings that went forward to represent the Breed in the Supreme Championships were Lyn King's Caegwyn Bedazzled for the Purebreds and Waterside Stud's Waterside Blue Token for the Partbreds.

The purebred ridden classes saw the emergence of a new Champion in the shape of Tipuana Stud's imported stallion, Waxwing Talisman, competently shown by Alex Williamson whilst the Partbred Championship was won by Waterside Stud's Waterside Love Story, shown by Carol Dollery.

The leadrein and first pony classes are always well supported at this show; the Champion Purebred Young Child's Showing Pony was Caegwyn Bedazzled ridden by Rania Motari with Llandilo Lillybrook and Olivia Morris as Reserve. The Purebred Working Championship was won by Llandilo Sentinel and Storm Human, with Olivia and Lillybrook again taking Reserve.

In the Partbred Section the Showing Champion was Foresyte Peek-a-boo and Leeyah Bhikhoo Rakim and the Working Champion was Waterside Leroy Brown ridden by Peter Hall.

After an interval of more than four years we also had a competitor in our Welsh Harness classes with Llandilo Harvard acquitting himself very well to take both the Single Harness & Private Drive Championships.

The Sunday of Horse of the year is the day of Supreme Championships which sees all the Breed Champions and Champions from the other ridden divisions competing against each other for a place in the top five of each category.

Gwyddls Showtime was 4th in the Breed Supreme, a class which involved over 40 mares and stallions whilst Waterside Blue Token was the Reserve Supreme in the Gelding category.

The Young Children's category was dominated by Welsh ponies and the Supreme Championship was awarded to Llandilo Hawaii, owned by Dolarch Stud and shown by Olivia Morris. The Reserve went to the 21 yr old Llandilo Sentinel, owned by Megan Hanes.

Autumn Gold Cup 7th & 8th April 2018

On the same lines as Horse of the Year and held a month later at the picturesque Inanda Country Base, Autumn Gold Cup generates much smaller entries although the quality is always high.

As with HoY, Sunday afternoon sees the judging of the Supreme Interbreed classes and the Welsh, as always were well to the fore. The Breed Supreme was won by Sharon Ralston's Cob Mare Freyja Fflam Goch, with a thoroughbred in Reserve.

The Top Five Ridden Championship featured two Welsh Ponies, with the Partbred Waterside Double Date ridden by Lunathi Mdlungu in 3rd place (as well as Champion Child Rider/Pony combination) and the Purebred Caegwyn Bedazzled in 5th. Caegwyn Bedazzled was also the Reserve Champion Gelding and Waterside Double Date the Reserve Champion Working Horse/Pony.

National Championships 2018

The 2018 Welsh Pony & Cob Society National Championships will be held in conjunction with the **Robertson Agricultural Show** from 2nd to 6th October 2018

These championships will only be open to paid-up members of the Welsh Pony and Cob Society of South Africa and no late entries, entries on the day or unapproved changes to entries will be allowed.

The classes will be the same as those offered in 2017 with the inclusion of a Beginner Drivers' class.

There will be separate Junior & Senior Sec. A Championships and the top 5 from each of these Championships will contend the Supreme Championship on Saturday.

The Fine harness will become a Championship class in its own right.

Guidelines for Harness Classes

These guidelines are taken from the Official Show Rules of the Welsh Pony & Cob Society of South Africa and form the basis on which all Welsh harness classes are judged.

Gaits

40.1 Single Harness

- a) WALK. The walk must be flat-footed. An animated walk simulating a short gait or jog is not permitted and must be discriminated against.
- b) WORKING TROT. This is a slow trot but the speed as such is unimportant. It is a gait that can be kept up for long distances without overtiring the pony.
- c) EXTENDED TROT. This is intended to show the “up and forward” action of the Welsh Pony or Cob. It is not a race and speed will vary with the individual pony.

40.2 Fine Harness & Ladies Fine Harness

The gait is a slow, stylish showy trot. Ponies will come back to a walk to change direction.

Recommendations for Driving Classes

1. Natural Action

The Welsh breed has a beautiful natural action which should be preserved at all costs. This action is quick, free and straight from the shoulder, well away in front to give a high reaching action. Hocks should be well flexed with straight and powerful leverage and well under the body.

2. Colour

Because Welsh Ponies cover the entire colour spectrum of recognized colours in horses, lesser emphasis should be laid on matched colours. Of all the requirements needed to make an excellent pair, matched colour is by far the least important and should, therefore, only ever be a recommendation and never a requirement. Breeders must never be tempted to breed substandard animals for the sake of colour.

3. General Impression

The outstandingly good temperament of the Welsh Pony is one of the two most important characteristics of the breed and it should be easily observed in all Welsh classes. When in motion ponies must give the impression that they are happy and enjoying themselves. Their carriage must be proud and dignified.

4. Single Harness

- 4.1 The overall picture is important.
- 4.2 Style, set, action and balance must be maintained throughout the class whenever the pony is in movement.
- 4.3 The head should be carried proudly and gaily with no star-gazing or over-bending. The mouth must be shut and the pony must not give the impression it is unhappy with the bit. The driven pony should always be comfortably up on the bit indicating conscious obedience.
- 4.4 Action must be flowing and harmonious. Short, choppy strides must be discouraged.
- 4.5 The pony should not break into a canter, but if it does it must come back to a trot without any problems. If the pony breaks often it must be discriminated against.
- 4.6 At the trot all four legs must maintain an even rhythm. The pony should not trail its hind legs nor canter with its hind legs while trotting in front.
- 4.7 The pony must be easy to handle. At a walk the pony should be able to make an about turn in any direction when asked to do so, to demonstrate its obedience.
- 4.8 When asked to “drive on” or “show your ponies” the judge must discriminate against overdriving. Exhibitors cannot expect their ponies to maintain style and balance if they drive them too fast.

Hy was ook lief om met leer te werk en het sy eie dubbel leer halters gemaak en tuie reggemaak waar nodig.

As teler het hy groot hoogtes bereik. Baie van sy aanteel doen tans goed in die skoubaan en het ander ponie liefhebbers in staat gestel om te skou of met hul eie stoetery te begin.

In 2014 het hy erelidmaatskap van die Vereniging ontvang vir sy bydrae tot die bedryf.

Ons sal sy geselsies, raad en aanmoediging langs die skoubaan baie mis.

He did not miss one national SA championship from 3yrs old to 28 years old. The most successful welsh pony in SA ever with

At his peak he would enter 24 classes at one SA champs, competing with children, ladies and men in working classes, harness, dressage and many more- VERSATILE. Not always the best in confirmation but when he entered the show arena with a saddle or harness on him he was transformed and became a giant. The most SA championships he won in one year was 12.

He competed in shows, dressage, show jumping, polo cross, endurance riding, gymkhana and “boere sports”.

He was more than a horse, he was part of the family.

We will all miss him.
